

Source: Based on 39 active or completed projects from November 2013 through December 2020.





### **RFP Purpose**

#### **Purpose**

Provide a pre-apprenticeship training and/or job readiness program to place individuals, with a focus on Priority Hire individuals, into registered construction apprenticeship programs and/or clean energy jobs.



#### **Outcome**

Reduce economic inequities by opening doors to well-paying construction careers and clean energy jobs for underrepresented groups to enter and maintain employment.




# **Priority Hire Individuals**

# Scope of Work

 RFP Scope of Work: Propose a pre-apprenticeship training program and/or job readiness program to place individuals, with a focus on Priority Hire individuals, into registered apprenticeship programs and/or clean energy jobs.

 Joint Proposals: Organizations may submit joint proposals. Joint proposals are strongly encouraged, but not required.



### Registered Construction Apprenticeship and Clean Energy Jobs

- Registered Construction Apprenticeships are any WSATC-registered construction apprenticeships.
- <u>Clean Energy Jobs</u> are construction jobs and/or WSATC-registered apprenticeships that focus on clean and renewable energy, including the construction, installation, maintenance and operation of these systems. Example List Below:
